How can I get involved?

Cheshire East Prayer Watch – Can you commit a hour or half an hour on a regular basis to help see continuous prayer across the area through each day and night?

24 hours x 7 days x 52 weeks of prayer - A relay of 52 weeks of prayer as one town or groups of churches completes a week of prayer and passes the baton to the next, keeping the flame of prayer moving across Cheshire East. *Can you help organise, host and join with others to take part in one or more weeks?*

Adopt a street in prayer - Could you commit to praying regularly for one or two neighbouring families or those living alone?

Prayer request cards- Can you deliver these to neighbours' homes, colleagues, friends and join with others to pray about these requests?

Neighbourhood Prayer Guides – Could you use the prayer guides to record the names of key leaders in your community and pray for them and watch things change.

Praying the Lord's Prayer at Midday - Can you take 5 minutes each day at midday, or as near as you are able and pray the Lord's prayer wherever you are?
